**It is again time to implement the K-5 Family Life Education (FLE) curriculum for Franklin County, which has been adopted by the School Board. If you are not familiar with the FLE program, you may pick up a copy of the curriculum outline from the clinic.**

**The curriculum in general is scope with presentation of state-mandated concepts and information being its major thrust. There will be no tests or grades given to students already being implemented in other areas such as social studies, science, and health as well as through regular classroom management procedures.**

**Some FLE curriculum objectives will require a separate instructional block of time and some of them will be taught in sex-separated classrooms. Topics, which will require such instruction, are so noted on the curriculum guide. Instruction in these topics this year will take place on June 3, 2011. Parents, upon request, can review copies of resource materials to be used during the FLE instruction.**

**There exists in the state legislation a mandate to implement FLE instruction and opportunity for parents to opt their child out of the specific FLE instruction. Children whose parents have opted them out will be provided an alternative learning activity during the FLE period(s) of instruction.
